35 DRIVERS, EIGHT NATIONS, ONE SUPER SPORTSCAR: “BATTLE” ON THE SALZBURGRING WITH THE X-BOW!

Could it be just a bit more perhaps? Following its successful first season the KTM X-BOW BATTLE 2011 is about to go into action once more! No less that 35 drivers will be on the grid for the first race on the Salzburgring and those are the ones that were the quickest to register because there is a limit of 35 starters on this ultra fast circuit just outside Salzburg. This means some of those who wanted to race had to go on a waiting list and now must be content to watch these first races on Friday (April 29) and Saturday (April 30). But it's certainly not going to be boring. The starters come from eight nations and will be hitting the gas hard in three different classes. This is the guarantee of exciting race action!

The “Unlimited class” will be the fastest on the circuit. The KTM X-BOW, the ‘Made in Austria’ super sports car will be on the track with up to 375 h.p. And that is enough for a good 250 km/h on the long straight leading up to the paddock bend. The “usual suspects” like last year’s champ Jim Gebhardt, Ex-rally ace Raphael Sperrer or KTM board member Hubert Trunkenpolz or indeed a very special guest: Abdulaziz Turki Al-Faisal, the reigning Porsche Cup Middle East Champion, are all “Ready To Race”! This very fast driver from Saudi Arabia is not only one of the most successful racing drivers from the entire Middle East region; he is also the first athlete from this country to be sponsored by Red Bull! Al-Faisal will be on the start, invited by KTM in a brand new X-BOW “R”. It remains to be seen how the fully professional driver fares in the series car amidst the h.p. monsters. What is already certain is that he’s going to have a lot of fun – him and all the other drivers in the “Battle”!
