## THE KTM X-BOW HILL CLIMB TROPHY 2011: RACE TO THE SUMMIT IN AUSTRIA, GERMANY AND ITALY!

It's all about to happen in exactly one week's time. That's when competition begins for the second season of the KTM X-BOW HILLCLIMB TROPHY as part of the legendary Rechberg Race! Organizer Dominik Olbert has had many new ideas in 2011 on how to successfully conduct this hill climb race series and he has also found a new partner. In Thomas Rössler he has found no-one less than the German Hill Climb Racing Champion from 2010, who, with his "Rössler Racing Team" can call upon 30 years of experience on the racing circuit and above all, in the sport of hill climbing. In addition, the series focuses on the core market countries of the X-BOW and for this reason, there will be races in Austria and Germany as part of the Austrian and the German Automobile Hill Climb Championship.

Dominik Olbert is especially pleased about the cooperation with Thomas Rössler and his team: "It's really great for the KTM X-BOW HILL CLIMB TROPHY. There are not many people who have as much experience in hill climbing as the guys from Rössler Racing. We will work very closely with them and as well as a central paddock area, we also plan a common mechanics pool which will look after the needs of both Thomas, who will contest the hill climb in his new Osella, and the starters in our own HILL CLIMB TROPHY." Olbert's focus on Austria and Germany is a logical consequence of the experiences of last season. "We talked to our customers but also with many interested parties. It was a very clear wish that the races should not be too far away. We took this into consideration but we still have come up with a very varied and attractive mix of activities for the series," he said.

It is expected that there will be between 10-15 starters per race for the coming season but naturally so-called "arrive and drive" packages can also be booked. For this there is a race-ready KTM X-BOW inclusive of Racing Service to hire at just 1,290- Euro (including VAT) for one of the total of six race weekends. This guarantees that the dream of an adrenalin rush while attacking the summit with support from up to 30,000 enthusiastic fans no longer needs simply to be a dream! On top of this, the rally aces Kris Rosenberger and Patrick Winter will also be standing by to act as official instructors. Taking part in your own KTM X-BOW is naturally possible. Every model is suitable to start in the hill climb and it doesn't have to be street legal. In addition to winning the KTM X-BOW HILL CLIMB TROPHY, for which count a total of the four best results during 2011, there is also a chance to be Austrian National KTM X-BOW Hill Climbing Champion – a real Austrian title.
